Pet Owner Requirements



Below are the City of Lake Park Pet Owner Requirements:

- City Ordinance 3-3 requires all <u>dogs</u> in Lake Park to be licensed. Licenses are issued at the Lake Park Clerk's Office at 2032 2nd Street.
- The Rabies Vaccination Certificate must be provided showing the expiration date of the vaccine.
- The Certificate is good for 1 year, 2 years or 3 years, and the expiration date of the rabies vaccination will be reflected on the Certificate.
- Cats are not required to be licensed.
- Cats and dogs <u>must be leashed</u> within City limits and may not run at large. Fines may be assessed.
- Please <u>do not</u> leave your pets near utility meters. Meters not read due to pet interference will be estimated.

- The fee for dog licenses are determined by the following:
